Things to remember when booking a photographer

It can be overwhelming booking suppliers for your wedding day. Here's what to look for when securing your photographer.

- Ensure they have experience, the more the better.
 - Quality over quantity. Don't get caught up in receiving 2000 images, I'm sure you'd rather 600 amazing ones than thousands of average ones.
 - Price often reflects the end product and service you'll receive. It's best to invest well in photography which will last a lifetime.
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length of coverage

Choosing the length of coverage is up to you. However to help guide you, I can suggest what works and how long is best to have to cover everything you'll need and love for your photography.



How long to book....

I always advise to book as long as you can afford. Capturing all the moments throughout the day makes your wedding story complete, beautiful and varied. I class a full day wedding as 8 hours and that's **only £1400 off peak/£1800 peak** and normally includes everything from bridal prep right until your first dance! But the coverage length is up to you and is available per hour!

If you'd like bridal prep covered, as a rule I advise the coverage to start 1.5 hours prior to your ceremony time (or prior to you leaving a location to go to your ceremony) and if you'd like your first dance covered and a bit of dancing, this finishes your wedding story wonderfully. Add more hours after the first dance to capture lots of party footage and memorable dancing with your guests!

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£175 per hour Oct–Apr

£225 per hour May–Sept

- Bespoke coverage. *Depending on your choosing.*
- Consultation to discuss your day in person or via phone.
- Private online gallery to view and download your photos.
- All images edited in my signature style.

**Coverage must be consecutive. Additional hours after agreed timings charged at £225/175ph. Travel charge for locations over 30 miles from CO7. These are current prices and may increase.*



Additional extras

Second shooter for groom prep–end of speeches £300. This is good for different venues and alternative angles from the day.

If you fancy a practice run, some gorgeous couple shots or a chance to work with me before your day, a pre-wedding session is beneficial £150, 40mins, 10 images, local location to CO7.

Important bits you need to know...

- If you wish to book I require a signed contract and £300 booking fee. This secures your date. No dates are held.
- Remaining payments can be made in instalments or in one lump sum, your choice, as long as it’s all settled 1 month prior to your wedding date.
- You’re welcome to book before having a meeting, there’s lots of time for catch ups!
